The Australian Society of Miniature Art was conceived in 1984 by Australian artist Janine Bravery, with the first official meeting being held on 21 June 1985.

Members of the society work across a range of media, in both traditional forms such as watercolour, oil or acrylic painting, printmaking, drawing and mixed media as well as abstract work, sculpture and hand-made books.

Many of the artists are professionals of long-standing who reside Australia-wide. There are award-winning artists who regularly exhibit larger works but who have an affinity for the discipline of working in miniature. Standards are very high, with rigorous selection for exhibiting membership as well as for entry to each exhibition. The exhibitions always have an interesting mix of traditional and modern.

A good miniature work can convey all the beauty and power of a larger work of art but has the added appeal of being a particularly personal object. Miniatures draw the viewer in for a closer look.

History

The art of the miniature is many hundreds of years old. In the Western world the earliest examples can be found in the illuminated capital letters of church manuscripts, and the portrait miniature became important as a record of loved ones, particularly in the Romantic era. Miniatures also have a long history in India, Iran and Russia.

Definition

The Australian Society of Miniature Art definition for a two-dimensional work is that the perimeter of the actual art work must not exceed 40cm. A three-dimensional work must not exceed 15cm in any direction, and the front cover of a handmade miniature book must have a perimeter of no more than 40cm.
