Artemis in Athens

Our robotics team, Artemis, was selected to represent Australia in the 2024 First Global Challenge held in Athens. This prestigious robotics competition features teams from 193 countries, each team building a robot to compete in a unique game. Over two months, our talented girls prepared diligently, designing and constructing their



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robot while collaborating online with overseas teams from places including China, Palestine, Bangladesh and Vietnam.

The experience began with a spectacular opening ceremony at the Panathenaic Stadium, where the girls were inspired by Dean Kamen, the founder of FIRST, who spoke about international unity and the importance of collaboration among nations. Competing against the best, our team achieved a remarkable rank of 47th out of 193 – a fantastic accomplishment!

In addition to the competition, our girls were invited to various evening ceremonies, including a cultural festival showcasing Greek music and delicious food. They also had the extraordinary opportunity to meet Australia's Ambassador to Greece, Ms Alison Duncan, whose insights into her diplomatic career inspired our students.

Biennial Music Tour to Spain and Portugal

Meanwhile, 63 of our talented musicians, alongside seven dedicated staff members, travelled to Spain and Portugal for our biennial Music Tour. Over two weeks, they performed at venues across many cities, attended masterclasses with European maestros and soaked up those countries' rich culture through sightseeing and engaging activities.

Highlights included a memorable performance at a school in Seville and a strings masterclass at the Metropolitana Symphony Orchestra Hall in Lisbon. Our choir also participated in a choral workshop with Erica Mandillo and the University of Lisbon's Children's Choir. The girls also enjoyed a flamenco dancing workshop, followed by a delicious Spanish dinner and a captivating professional flamenco show.

The tour culminated with a visit to the breathtaking Alhambra in Granada, leaving our students with unforgettable memories and experiences.

These overseas tours are truly life-changing experiences, and both the Robotics and Music tours exemplified the perfect blend of learning and enjoyment. Such invaluable experiences would not be possible without the incredible hard work, passion, and dedication of our wonderful teachers. Their commitment to ensuring our girls are prepared and have a rich educational and cultural experience speaks volumes about the values we uphold at Abbotsleigh. The Outsiders

It is a common experience to feel like an outsider at various times in our lives. It might be because we don't have the same fashion as others, get chosen last for a team game, or are not up-to-date with the fad on the 'socials'. There may be much more difficult reasons and it is easy to feel isolated, different and unvalued. This term, our Senior Chapels are centred around 'The Outsiders', highlighting the many interactions Jesus had with individuals deemed 'outsiders'. Some of these people lived outside the city because they were considered unclean, like those with leprosy. Many had reduced social status, like tax collectors, who were considered traitors, or those who had broken certain moral rules. Jesus comes and spends time with these outsiders, welcoming them when others don't and giving them the good news of forgiveness with God through faith in Him. The words of the hymn we are learning resonate, 'What a friend we have in Jesus all our sins and griefs to bear... can we find a friend so faithful who will all our sorrows share?... In his arms He'll take and shield you, you will find a solace there.'
