Road trip to Christmas

With Halloween behind us, the Christmas season in the shops is now in full swing. Christmas trees are up, enormous baubles are hanging from the ceiling, the Santa photo booth is ready with a sign pointing to the North Pole, and there are plenty of items to start buying. Personally, I prefer to wait until four weeks before Christmas, but many preparations need to happen well in advance. This year our Junior School Carols will be on Thursday 28 November and Senior Carols on Sunday 1 December, marking the beginning of Advent.

This term, Boarder Chapel is taking a road trip through parts of the Bible that were signs pointing to Jesus coming that first Christmas. In Junior School, we've encountered some totally unexpected Old Testament stories that hint at someone coming. While I don't want to rush the year by thinking about Christmas too early, it is helpful to recalibrate my thoughts and remember that God had planned Jesus' arrival hundreds of years before the baby in the manger appeared. Here are just a few of the verses written more than 600 years before that first Christmas.

Isaiah 9:6-7

A child has been born for us. We have been given a son who will be our ruler. His names will be Wonderful Advisor and Mighty God, Eternal Father and Prince of Peace. His power will never end; peace will last forever.

Micah 5:2

Bethlehem Ephrath, you are one of the smallest towns in the nation of Judah. But the Lord will choose one of your people to rule the nation – someone whose family goes back to ancient times.
