Conditions

The Kathleen McCredie Award was created in perpetuity to honour Old Girl Miss Kathleen McCredie, Headmistress of Abbotsleigh 1970-1987. This Award, established by the Abbotsleigh Old Girls' Union, will enable a girl who, but for the Award, would not be able to attend or remain at Abbotsleigh.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Kathleen McCredie Award is available to new applicants or current Abbotsleigh students entering Year 10 in 2026 who are eligible under these conditions and criteria below.
- 2. The Award will provide financial assistance up to 100% remission of school tuition fees for one girl entering Year 10 and will be tenable for three (3) years provided work, conduct and general activities are thoroughly satisfactory.
- 3. The criteria for this Award, as set out in the Rules of the Award, are that the successful candidate shall:
 - a) display significant all round involvement in spiritual, service, cultural and sporting activities;
 - b) have achieved a high standard of academic excellence;
 - c) be in a financial position (including her and her family) such as not to be able to attend Abbotsleigh without the aid of the Award and satisfy the requirements of the Welfare Fund; and
 - d) preferably be a boarder, this not being a compulsory criterion for the Award.
- 4. The process for selection, as set out in the Trust Deed of the Award is as follows:
 - a) The applicant will complete an application providing details as specified in the attached application form.
 - b) The applicant will submit her most recent school report with her application form.
 - c) If the applicant fulfils the Criteria, she will be granted an interview before the Selection Panel.
 - d) The Selection Panel may discuss the applicant's suitability with a referee nominated by the applicant.
 - e) The Selection Panel has unfettered discretion to determine the student who best fulfils the Criteria.
 - f) The Selection Panel is not obliged to award the Award.
- 5. The Award will not be awarded in cash, but will represent a discount on the successful applicant's tuition fees for as long as the applicant remains at Abbotsleigh and satisfies all the conditions of the Award.

The amount of the discount will be determined by the AOGU and is based upon the financial capacity of the Trust. Provided finances allow, it is intended that the discount will be 100% of the applicant's tuition fees.

- 6. No student may recieve financial assistance from this award while concurrently on a scholarship.
- 7. The recipient of this Award may be announced within the School community, with the consent of the recipient.

Note - The applicant should retain a copy of these conditions.
